

Gospel Meditation:

A young couple in my parish told me they were expecting their second child, a baby boy.

I knew that their five-year old only child Emma had been desperately wanting to be a big sister for years, so I said, *"Emma must have been so happy when you told her the news." "Actually,*" they said, *"she burst into tears. She wanted a baby sister!*" How often in life God wonderfully fulfills our desires and we are sad because we don't approve of the way he does it. We want to control the gift and the delivery method.

The same thing occurs in the Gospel this week when Jesus announces in his hometown that the promise of an Anointed One bringing glad tidings to the poor is "*fulfilled in your hearing*" (*Luke 4:21*).

After a moment of elation, his fellow townsfolk realize this man is the way God is fulfilling his promises, and they erupt into a violent outburst. So Jesus departs. How sad for them.

Every single Sunday at Mass, including this one, some version of this happens to many of us. God's word announces the fulfillment of God's promises in Christ, and we easily overlook or disdain it. His way is almost never according to our narrow expectations. What's required of us is to set these aside, and to embrace a new openness to God's gifts, no matter how he wishes to give them. God is fulfilling his promises the way He likes — why be sad?

<u>Meditación del Evangelio:</u>

Una joven pareja de mi parroquia me dijo que estaban esperando su segundo hijo, un bebé. Sabía que su única hija de cinco años, Emma, había querido desesperadamente ser una hermana mayor durante años, así que le dije: "*Emma debe haber estado tan feliz cuando le contaste la noticia*". "*En realidad*", dijeron, "*rompió a llorar. ¡Quería una hermanita!*" Cuántas veces en la vida Dios cumple maravillosamente nuestros deseos y estamos tristes porque no aprobamos la forma en que lo hace. Queremos controlar el regalo y el método de entrega.

Lo mismo ocurre en el Evangelio de esta semana cuando Jesús anuncia en su ciudad natal que la promesa de un Ungido que trae buenas nuevas a los pobres se ha "*cumplido a oídos tuyos*" (*Lucas 4:21*). Después de un momento de júbilo, sus conciudadanos se dan cuenta de que este hombre es la forma en que Dios está cumpliendo sus promesas, y estallan en un arrebato violento. Así que Jesús se va. Qué triste para ellos.

Todos los domingos en la Misa, incluyendo este, alguna versión de esto nos sucede a muchos de nosotros. La palabra de Dios anuncia el cumplimiento de las promesas de Dios en Cristo, y fácilmente la pasamos por alto o la desdeñamos. Su camino casi nunca está de acuerdo con nuestras estrechas expectativas. Lo que se requiere de nosotros es dejar esto a un lado y abrazar una nueva apertura a los dones de Dios, sin importar cómo El desee darlos. Dios está cumpliendo sus promesas de la manera que le gusta, ¿por qué estar triste?
