Gospel Meditation:

During my baseball career, my best coach often said, "You shouldn't be worried if I yell at you. Be worried if I don't. If I stop pushing you, it means I don't think you have potential." He demanded a lot, and I knew it meant he saw that I could be something special on the baseball field.

Jesus says some demanding words to us this week. "Do you think I have come to establish peace on the earth?" he ask "No, tell you, but rather division "(Luke 12:51)He wants you and me —in fact, all the earth—to participate in the luminous glory of God. That's why he speaks of himself as a divine arsonist. Divine fire is like a good coach: it demands the removal of all that obstructs the achievement of the lofty goal.

How is your life demanding right now? That inconvenient family situation, the unfair boss at work, the kids who reject their parents 'wishes, the nagging health issue? Maybe things would be more peaceful devoid of these seemingly arbitrary difficulties. But for us who believe in the one who comes to set the earth of fire, we should be much from us. In fact, let's thank him for it. He sees how glorious we can become.

Meditación del Evangelio:

Durante mi carrera en el béisbol, mi mejor entrenador a menudo decía: "No deberías preocuparte si te grito. Preocúpate si no lo hago. Si dejo de presionarte, significa que no creo que tengas potencial". Exigía mucho, y sabía que significaba que veía que podía ser algo especial en el campo de béisbol.

Jesús nos dice algunas palabras exigentes esta semana. "¿Pensáis que he venido a establecer la paz en la tierra?" él pregunta: "No, os lo diréis, sino más bien división" (Lucas 12:51)Él quiere que tú y yo, de hecho, toda la tierra, participemos en la gloria luminosa de Dios. Por eso habla de sí mismo como un pirómano divino. El fuego divino es como un buen entrenador: exige la eliminación de todo lo que obstruye el logro de la meta elevada.

¿Cómo es tu vida exigente en este momento? ¿Esa situación familiar inconveniente, el jefe injusto en el trabajo, los niños que rechazan los deseos de sus padres, el problema de salud persistente? Tal vez las cosas serían más pacíficas sin estas dificultades aparentemente arbitrarias. Pero para nosotros que creemos en el que viene a prender fuego a la tierra, deberíamos estar muy lejos de nosotros. De hecho, agradezcamos por ello. Él ve cuán gloriosos podemos llegar a ser.


Queenship of Mary

Question:

Why do we have a feast for the Queenship of Mary?

Answer:

For many of us, the language of kings and queens may seem like they belong to history or a medieval movie. Royalty have absolute authority over a kingdom and their subjects, a concept that is foreign to many of us to-day. While Jesus doesn't rule a political kingdom, we honor and recognize him as the King of Kings, Lord of Heaven and Earth. To God alone belongs absolute authority over all of existence.



We may think of queens as the spouse of the king, but there is another key relationship: the king's mother. In Biblical history, we see instances where the mother of the king is given due as a queen herself, complete with a throne! Mary's guiding influence over her Son is seen most notably in the Wedding Feast at Cana. Mary is not Queen on her own merit. She is "full of grace" and "blessed" in "all ages" because of the reign of her Son.


