Gospel Meditation:

Before I was a priest, I was a lazy worker for a retail Apple store. Hearing a rumor that my boss was going to fire me, I secretly sold iPhones for half-price, gave away dozens of free iPads, and donated several brand-new laptops to managers in other stores in the mall. After a week, my boss called me into his office. He knew what I was up to. He said I had cost the store thousands of dollars. "Really great work, John," he said. "I am going to recommend you to be my assistant manager and double your pay." I was amazed.

And so are you. Which is understandable because it never happened. How could it?

My tall tale is a retelling of Jesus' brow-furrowing parable we hear this week.

A lazy, dishonest steward defrauds his boss and then the "master commended the dishonest servant for acting prudently" (Luke 16:8). What is the Lord saying to us?

Most of us treat our spiritual lives like a lazy teenager at an Apple store. We really don't care.

We go through the motions. Then, if we are lucky, something happens that shakes us to spiritual action; to employ whatever time, money, and resources we have to build around us a strong network of love. Every saint did that. Our Lord is so good he wants us to use his stuff to forgive debts and to bless others. He wants us to ensure our future. So do it

<u>Meditación del Evangelio:</u>

Antes de ser sacerdote, era un trabajador perezoso de una tienda minorista de Apple. Al escuchar un rumor de que mi jefe me iba a despedir, vendí en secreto iPhones a mitad de precio, regalé docenas de iPads gratis y doné varias computadoras portátiles nuevas a los gerentes de otras tiendas del centro comercial. Después de una semana, mi jefe me llamó a su oficina. Sabía lo que estaba haciendo. Dijo que le había costado a la tienda miles de dólares. "Realmente un gran trabajo, John", dijo. "Te voy a recomendar que seas mi asistente de gerente y duplique tu salario". Me quedé asombrado.

Y tú también. Lo cual es comprensible porque nunca sucedió. ¿Cómo podría? Mi cuento es un recuento de la parábola de Jesús que frunce el ceño y escuchamos esta semana.

Un mayordomo perezoso y deshonesto defrauda a su jefe y luego el "amo elogió al siervo deshonesto por actuar con prudencia" (Lucas 16:8). ¿Qué nos está diciendo el Señor?

La mayoría de nosotros tratamos nuestra vida espiritual como un adolescente perezoso en una tienda de Apple. Realmente no nos importa. Seguimos los movimientos. Entonces, si tenemos suerte, sucede algo que nos sacude a la acción espiritual; emplear el tiempo, el dinero y los recursos que tengamos para construir a nuestro alrededor una fuerte red de amor. Todos los santos hicieron eso. Nuestro Señor es tan bueno que quiere que usemos sus cosas para perdonar deudas y bendecir a otros. Quiere que aseguremos nuestro futuro. *Así que hazlo*

To feed souls the Bread of Life;


To comfort the suffering & dying, and
