Gospel Meditation:

Not long ago, I was called to a hospital to anoint a woman in her early 80s. She was dying, and visibly in pain. But what struck me most wasn't her suffering — it was the atmosphere in the room. She had eight children and 30 foster kids, and many of them were gathered around her. You'd expect sorrow, fear, maybe even despair. But the room was filled with something else entirely — a quiet strength, a kind of sweetness. It was as if she was suffering not just with them, but for them. And they, in love, were suffering for her. The pain was real, But so was the peace. I didn't want to run. I felt as if I was in a little paradise, beeping machines and all.

I think of that moment when I hear today's Gospel. Jesus, hanging on the cross, doesn't look like a king. But one of the crucified, dying men beside him sees through the suffering and says, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom" (Luke 23:42). That word — remember — literally means to make someone a member again. He's asking to be joined to Christ, to become part of his Body. And Jesus says, "Today you will be with me in paradise."

He doesn't say, "I'll take your suffering away." He says, "You will be with me."

That's the strange power of Christ the King. He doesn't rule by avoiding suffering. He reigns by entering into it, and transforming it with love.

What are you suffering right now in your life? Likely you want it to stop. But if we are willing to suffer with him paradise begins even today.

Meditación del Evangelio:

No hace mucho, me llamaron a un hospital para ungir a una mujer de poco más de 80 años. Estaba muriendo y visiblemente dolida. Pero lo que más me impactó no fue su sufrimiento, sino el ambiente en la sala. Tenía ocho hijos y 30 niños en acogida, y muchos de ellos estaban reunidos a su alrededor. Esperarías tristeza, miedo, quizá incluso desesperación. Pero la habitación estaba llena de algo completamente distinto: una fuerza silenciosa, una especie de dulzura. Era como si sufriera no solo con ellos, sino por ellos. Y ellos, enamorados, sufrían por ella. El dolor era real. Pero también lo era la paz. No quería correr. Sentía que estaba en un pequeño paraíso, con máquinas que pitaban y todo.

Pienso en ese momento en que escucho el Evangelio de hoy. Jesús, colgado en la cruz, no parece un rey. Pero uno de los crucificados y moribundos a su lado ve a través del sufrimiento y dice: "Jesús, acuérdate de mí cuando entres en tu reino" (Lucas 23:42). Esa palabra — recuerda — significa literalmente volver a hacer a alguien miembro. Está pidiendo unirse a Cristo, convertirse en parte de su Cuerpo. Y Jesús dice: "Hoy estarás conmigo en el paraíso."

No dice: "Te quitaré el sufrimiento." Él dice: "Estarás conmigo."

Ese es el extraño poder de Cristo Rey. No gobierna evitando el sufrimiento. Reina al entrar en ella y transformarla con amor.

¿Qué estás sufriendo ahora mismo en tu vida? Probablemente quieras que pare. Pero si estamos dispuestos a sufrir con él el paraíso comienza incluso hoy.

Is Christ King in Our Hearts?

We don't have much familiarity with kingship in modern American society.

Kings tend to make us uneasy. Presidents, on the other hand - we can handle, because we know we are a president's boss.

No matter how much power he has, we are the electorate.

We are the source of that power. We're comfortable with this arrangement.

But with kings it is profoundly different.
Traditionally, the king derives his power from God.
His rule bridges humanity with the divine.

We should reflect carefully on whether or not we have made Jesus Christ king in our hearts, or whether we regard him as a president.

The difference isn't just one of titles, it's one of roles.

Subjects do not demand anything of a king. They beseech. They entreat. They submit, and they accept.

Do we demand of Christ, or do we beseech?

Do we tolerate God's edicts with grumbling, or do we embrace His word?

The "good thief" treated Christ as a king.

His counterpart treated him as a president.

And it's worth remembering that Jesus Christ is <u>not</u> the <u>President</u> of the Universe.


