Gospel Meditation:

When I was in middle school, there were times I didn't want my fellow students to see my parents drop me off or pick me up in the school parking lot. I was embarrassed of my parents. Why? I have no idea. Maybe it was our station wagon. Or I didn't want to look like a little kid. But in retrospect that was a silly thing to do. I was a kid. And I had two parents who loved me and had built a wonderful family. I was afraid of the other kids' judgment. How silly! I should have been afraid of forgetting or downplaying my family, which is where my identity had its deep roots.

This is a way to understand Jesus' words to his disciples this Sunday, when he says, "Don't be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna." Fear, in this sense, refers to where we find our deepest identity and our highest love. That's why Jesus says next that when we acknowledge him before others, he will acknowledge us before the Father. It doesn't mean we're brash or boastful. But rather we unhesitatingly and humbly embrace our identity as followers of Jesus and children of God the Father. After all, if we love who we are and where we come from, who cares what the other kids think about us?

<u>Meditación del Evangelio:</u>

Cuando estaba en la escuela secundaria, había momentos en que no quería que mis compañeros vieran a mis padres dejarme o recogerme en el estacionamiento de la escuela. Estaba avergonzado de mis padres. ¿Por qué? Ni idea. Tal vez era nuestra camioneta. O no quería parecer un niño pequeño.

Pero en retrospectiva, eso fue una tontería. Yo era un niño. Y tenía dos padres que me amaban y habían construido una familia maravillosa. Tenía miedo del criterio de los otros niños. ¡Qué tontería! Debería haber tenido miedo de olvidar o minimizar a mi familia, que es donde mi identidad tenía sus raíces profundas.

Esta es una manera de entender las palabras de Jesús a sus discípulos este domingo, cuando dice: "No tengan miedo de los que matan el cuerpo pero no pueden matar el alma; más bien, ten miedo del que puede destruir tanto el alma como el cuerpo en Gehenna". El miedo, en este sentido, se refiere a dónde encontramos nuestra identidad más profunda y nuestro amor más elevado. Es por eso que Jesús dice a continuación que cuando lo reconocemos ante los demás, él nos reconocerá ante el Padre. No significa que seamos descarados o presumidos. Sino que sin dudar y humildemente aceptamos nuestra identidad como seguidores de Jesús e hijos de Dios el Padre. Después de todo, si amamos quiénes somos y de dónde venimos, ¿a quién le importa lo que los otros niños piensen de nosotros?




