# Gospel Meditation:

Dorothy Day, the great Catholic activist, doubted God's existence. At least in her early adult years. But something changed when after giving birth to her daughter, she experienced an overwhelming gratitude. She later described how, as she held her daughter, the only appropriate response was a kind of unlimited gratitude. She had done nothing to deserve such a gift — this tiny, miraculous life — but there she was, flooded with gratitude, completely undone by the love of such a Giver.

Something similar occurs in Luke 17:19 when Jesus tells a healed leper, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." This man had already received physical healing through his faith. But the moment of an even deeper transformation came when he turned back, fell at Jesus' feet, and gave thanks. Like Dorothy, this man's gratitude led him to encounter the Giver.

Isn't that what we want, too? Gratitude to God has the power to break our chains of sadness, bitterness, and disenchantment. It empowers us to step out of the prison of self-pity and into the reality of God's abundant love. It shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have received, from what wounds us to what heals us. Where do we learn this? The Mass. The priest prays: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks." Always. Everywhere. Not just when life is easy. Not just when prayers are answered as we expect. Gratitude is not a passive feeling; it is an act of faith. In the eucharist, we remember that Christ himself has given everything for us. And in this act of gratitude, we are healed.

# Meditación del Evangelio:

Dorothy Day, la gran activista católica, dudaba de la existencia de Dios. Al menos en sus primeros años de adultez. Pero algo cambió cuando después de dar a luz a su hija, experimentó una gratitud abrumadora. Más tarde describió cómo, mientras sostenía a su hija, la única respuesta apropiada era una especie de gratitud ilimitada. No había hecho nada para merecer tal regalo, esta pequeña y milagrosa vida, pero allí estaba, inundada de gratitud, completamente deshecha por el amor de tal Dador.

Algo similar ocurre en Lucas 17:19 cuando Jesús le dice a un leproso sanado: "Levántate y vete; tu fe te ha salvado". Este hombre ya había recibido sanidad física a través de su fe. Pero el momento de una transformación aún más profunda llegó cuando se dio la vuelta, cayó a los pies de Jesús y dio gracias. Al igual que Dorothy, la gratitud de este hombre lo llevó a encontrarse con el Dador.

¿No es eso lo que queremos también? La gratitud a Dios tiene el poder de romper nuestras cadenas de tristeza, amargura y desencanto. Nos capacita para salir de la prisión de la autocompasión y entrar en la realidad del abundante amor de Dios. Cambia nuestro enfoque de lo que nos falta a lo que hemos recibido, de lo que nos hiere a lo que nos cura. ¿Dónde aprendemos esto? La Misa. El sacerdote reza: "Es verdaderamente correcto y justo, nuestro deber y nuestra salvación, siempre y en todas partes, darles gracias". Siempre. En todas partes. No solo cuando la vida es fácil. No solo cuando las oraciones son respondidas como esperamos. La gratitud no es un sentimiento pasivo; es un acto de fe. En la eucaristía, recordamos que Cristo mismo lo ha dado todo por nosotros. Y en este acto de gratitud, somos sanados.

Buckle Up... we're getting ready for my favorite time of the year!!

The weather will be cooling down soon... (then we can all complain about how cold it is ... lol) All the fall, Halloween, *Thanksgiving, and Christmas* decorations are out and available in the stores... (actually they've been out since August!!) And Feast Days!! We have sooo many days to celebrate! It's as if we're having a 2 or 3 month party! So... ENJOY!

We just celebrated the Feast of the Archangels (Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Rafael—the only angels mentioned by name in Scripture)

Then, we celebrated St. Jerome, Doctor of the Church. He translated most of the Bible (OT from Hebrew and NT from Greek and 'Old Latin). His translation is called the Vulgate and is still the source from which all Bible versions are based.

October is the "Month of the Rosary" (so come to Mass during the month a little early and bring your rosary), and on Oct 7<sup>th</sup> we celebrated our Blessed Mother as *Our Lady of the Rosary*.

On Wednesday, Oct 1st, we celebrated the Memorial of St. Therese of the Child Jesus... one of the Doctors of the Church; she is better known as the "Little Flower." In her many writings she advocated a simple lifestyle... saying all things, done with the right frame of mind, can be a prayer to honor and glorify God.

On Thursday, the 2<sup>nd</sup>, we celebrated the Memorial of the *Holy Guardian Angels*. Angels abound! We each have at least one to look after and guide us from the moment we are born... to the day we die. Just think of how many angels there must be! Literally billions and billions of them (and probably more!)!

Then to top off the week... on Saturday, Oct 4th, we celebrated the Memorial of St. Francis of Assisi. We have all heard of how he could communicate with the animals! The school children brought their pets and/or stuffed animals representing them to school on Friday to be blessed by Fr. Ed.

We also celebrate several Apostles and Popes during the month: St. Pope John XXIII on the 11th, St. Luke on the 18th, St. Pope John Paul II on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, St Simon and St. Jude on the 28<sup>th</sup>, among others.

To round out the month of October... we celebrate "All Hallows Eve" (Halloween) on the 31st... which leads us to our great celebration of "All Saints Day" on November 1st... where we honor and celebrate the Church Triumphant – all the saints in heaven, and "All Souls Day" on November 2<sup>nd</sup> where we celebrate the **Church Suffering** – the Holy Souls in Purgatory.
