# Gospel Meditation:

One of the most fascinating moments in American history is when George Washington could have become the king of the newly liberated United States and didn't. At the height of his power and fame, on Dec. 23, 1783, he resigned his commission as Commander-in-Chief, and went home. The astonished King of England remarked that in doing so, Washington was "the greatest man in the world." Greatness is often defined by what we could do but don't. Greatness is measured by the temptations we overcome.

Jesus' greatness is revealed in his victory over temptations, too. The three offered him by the devil contain, we might say, all potential possible temptations: food, power and fame. They correspond to the triple human needs of body, soul and spirit. In overcoming these three, he says "no" in essence to every and even the greatest temptation. We see that every desire of his humanity — body, soul and spirit — is perfectly united to God, to love. This is a power available to each member of his body. It is the path to true greatness. How can we, who so easily fall into even small temptations, find the power to overcome large ones? By entering into the great dynamics of Jesus' temptations.

*Lenten challenge:* This first week of Lent, list some concrete ways you can overcome temptations that correspond with your desires. For example, you may give up snacks between meals, choose not to participate in an activity of which you are an expert, and decide to reduce social media posting by 50%. It may not seem like much, but by saying "*no*" to the tyranny of food, power, and fame (*in this example*), you'll discover true greatness.

# <u>Meditación del Evangelio:</u>

Uno de los momentos más fascinantes de la historia de Estados Unidos es cuando George Washington podría haberse convertido en el rey de los Estados Unidos recién liberados y no lo hizo. En el apogeo de su poder y fama, el 23 de diciembre de 1783, renunció a su comisión como Comandante en Jefe y se fue a casa. El asombrado rey de Inglaterra comentó que, al hacerlo, Washington era "el hombre más grande del mundo". La grandeza a menudo se define por lo que podríamos hacer pero no lo hacemos. La grandeza se mide por las tentaciones que vencemos.

La grandeza de Jesús también se revela en su victoria sobre las tentaciones. Los tres que le ofrece el diablo contienen, podríamos decir, todas las tentaciones posibles posibles: alimento, poder y fama. Corresponden a las tres necesidades humanas de cuerpo, alma y espíritu. Al vencer estos tres, dice "no" en esencia a todas y cada una de las tentaciones más grandes. Vemos que todos los deseos de su humanidad —cuerpo, alma y espíritu— están perfectamente unidos a Dios, al amor. Este es un poder disponible para cada miembro de su cuerpo. Es el camino hacia la verdadera grandeza. ¿Cómo podemos nosotros, que caemos tan fácilmente incluso en tentaciones pequeñas, encontrar el poder para vencer las grandes? Entrando en la gran dinámica de las tentaciones de Jesús.

**Desafio de la Cuaresma:** Esta primera semana de Cuaresma, haz una lista de algunas formas concretas en las que puedes superar las tentaciones que corresponden a tus deseos. Por ejemplo, puede renunciar a los bocadillos entre comidas, optar por no participar en una actividad en la que es un experto y decidir reducir las publicaciones en las redes sociales en un 50%. Puede que no parezca mucho, pero al decir "*no*" a la tiranía de la comida, el poder y la fama (*en este ejemplo*), descubrirás la verdadera grandeza.


