

Gospel Meditation:

A few years ago, my house was broken into on Super Bowl Sunday. Turns out, it's a great day for burglars.

If the TV isn't on, people are probably watching the game somewhere else, so ... easy pickins'.

I'll never forget walking into my bedroom and realizing someone had been there. My stuff was thrown all over the floor. The closet was torn apart. It was discrienting and disturbing — someone had invaded the space I thought was secure.

The closet was torn apart. It was disorienting and disturbing — someone had invaded the space I thought was secure. After that, I bought an alarm system. And every Super Bowl Sunday since, I'm extra careful to lock the doors and keep the lights on. That experience made me more alert. Not scared. Just attentive.

That's much like the spiritual place Jesus wants us to be on this first Sunday of Advent.

He doesn't start the season with soft candlelight and cozy manger scenes.

He starts with two brutal images: a flood and a thief. In other words, chaos and violation.

Why? Because life will flood us. Chaos will come. And in the midst of it, Christ will come like a thief — not to steal from us, but to steal us back. He is the intruder we should want. The one who breaks in, not to ransack, but to rescue.

Christ presents himself as the thief but also the new Noah. He builds the ark of the Church to carry us through the flood. And he invites us to join him. How? By participating fully in our parishes. By making our homes places of prayer. By guarding our hearts with truth. By refusing to let spiritual complacency leave us exposed. By repentance.

This Advent, don't just stay vaguely "awake." Prepare. Build. Watch. The flood will come. But so will he.

<u>Meditación del Evangelio:</u>

Hace unos años, entraron a robar en mi casa el domingo de la Super Bowl. Resulta que es un gran día para los ladrones. Si la tele no está encendida, probablemente la gente esté viendo el partido en otro sitio, así que... Presas fáciles. Nunca olvidaré entrar en mi dormitorio y darme cuenta de que alguien había estado allí. Mis cosas estaban tiradas por todo el suelo. El armario estaba destrozado. Fue desorientador y perturbador — alguien había invadido el espacio que creía seguro. Después de eso, compré un sistema de alarma. Y cada domingo de la Super Bowl desde entonces, tengo mucho cuidado de cerrar las puertas con llave y mantener las luces encendidas. Esa experiencia me hizo estar más alerta. No tengo miedo. Solo atento.

Eso es muy parecido al lugar espiritual en el que Jesús quiere que estemos en este primer domingo de Adviento. No empieza la temporada con una luz suave de velas ni escenas de pesebre acogedor. Empieza con dos imágenes brutales: una inundación y un ladrón. En otras palabras, caos y violación.

¿Por qué? Porque la vida nos inundará. Llegará el caos. Y en medio de todo ello, Cristo vendrá como un ladrón — no para robarnos, sino para devolvernos. Es el intruso que deberíamos querer. El que irrumpe, no para saquear, sino para rescatar.

Cristo se presenta como el ladrón pero también como el nuevo Noé. Él construye el arca de la Iglesia para llevarnos a través del diluvio. Y nos invita a unirnos a él. ¿Cómo? Participando plenamente en nuestras parroquias. Haciendo de nuestros hogares lugares de oración. Protegiendo nuestros corazones con la verdad. Negándonos a dejar que la complacencia espiritual nos deje expuestos. Por arrepentimiento.

Este Adviento, no te quedes vagamente "despierto". Preparar. Construir. Reloj. El diluvio llegará. Pero él también lo hará.




