# Gospel Meditation:

Once I went to a hospice facility to celebrate Last Rites for an elderly dying man. His family had told me that he had been uncommunicative for days. At the conclusion of the ritual, we began to recite the Our Father prayer.

To everyone's surprise, his lips moved, clearly mouthing the words to the Lord's prayer.

Stripped of most of his faculties, the man could still pray those precious God-given petitions.

A lifetime of prayer had planted the words even deeper than his failing consciousness.

Do we want the Lord's prayer to be as deeply embedded in us? If we want to be people of hope, we should. Recall that our Lord immediately follows the prayer by saying: "Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you" (Luke 11:9). We only ask, search and knock because we hope that the request is not in vain. Everything we could possibly hope for is contained in the prayer. Praying the Our Father deepens our hope.

We should consciously pour all our hopes into the Lord's prayer; we should allow it to be an expression of hope, not simply rote words. Then, over time, it builds up our hope in God. It sinks deep into our souls and bodies. How blessed we are when these words of hope are on our lips, even when everything else seems to fail.

# Meditación del Evangelio:

Una vez fui a un centro de cuidados paliativos para celebrar los últimos ritos para un anciano moribundo. Su familia me había dicho que había estado poco comunicativo durante días. Al concluir el ritual, comenzamos a recitar la oración del Padre Nuestro. Para sorpresa de todos, sus labios se movieron, pronunciando claramente las palabras del Padre Nuestro. Despojado de la mayoría de sus facultades, el hombre aún podía rezar esas preciosas peticiones dadas por Dios. Toda una vida de oración había plantado las palabras aún más profundamente que su conciencia fallida.

¿Queremos que el Padre Nuestro esté tan profundamente arraigado en nosotros? Si queremos ser personas de esperanza, debemos hacerlo. Recordemos que nuestro Señor sigue inmediatamente la oración diciendo: "Pedid y se os dará; busca, y encontrarás; Ilamad, y se os abrirá" (Lucas 11:9). Solo pedimos, buscamos y llamamos porque esperamos que la petición no sea en vano. Todo lo que podríamos esperar está contenido en la oración. Rezar el Padre Nuestro profundiza nuestra esperanza.

Debemos verter conscientemente todas nuestras esperanzas en el Padre Nuestro; Debemos permitir que sea una expresión de esperanza, no simplemente palabras de memoria. Luego, con el tiempo, aumenta nuestra esperanza en Dios. Se hunde profundamente en nuestras almas y cuerpos. Qué bendecidos somos cuando estas palabras de esperanza están en nuestros labios, incluso cuando todo lo demás parece fallar.
